CAUTION

WHEN LOWERING TREE INTO PIT:

- 2 - 3 PEOPLE NEEDED
- LOWER GENTLY, DO NOT DROP
- DO NOT ALLOW THE ROOT BALL TO BREAK
- DO NOT USE TRUNK AS LEVER

LOWER TREE INTO PIT

CAUTION: DO NOT USE TRUNK TO LIFT OR LOWER

USE WIRE BASKET HANDLES ONLY

ROTATE TREE IN PIT TO ALIGN LONGEST BRANCHES PARALLEL TO CURB

-VIEWED FROM ABOVE-

CUT BASKET

CUT AWAY TOP 1/3 OF WIRE BASKET WITH BOLT CUTTERS

X = CUT HERE

#15

CUT BURLAP

CUT AWAY TOP 1/3 OF BURLAP WITH UTILITY KNIFE

--- = CUT LINE

START BACK-FILLING HOLE

USE SHOVEL HANDLE TO POKE OUT AIR POCKETS

CHECK THAT TRUNK IS VERTICAL IN 2 DIRECTIONS

COMPLETE-BACK FILLING HOLE

LIGHTLY TAMP SOIL

DO NOT BURY ROOT FLARE

#18

MULCH THE TREE WITH WOOD CHIPS

FORM A MULCH "DONUT" 3' TO 4" THICK

DO NOT BURY ROOT FLARE

#19

STAKE THE TREE (OPTIONAL)

#20

WATER THE TREE

WATER AT LEAST 10 GALLONS, ONCE A WEEK APRIL - OCT
